Lieutenant Colonel (retired) Charles Thomas “Tom” Calloway, 77, passed away in his home on May 15, 2019. A career Army officer and Vietnam veteran, Tom served his country through various deployments around the world including The Dominican Republic, Vietnam, Thailand, and Korea. He was awarded many military medals to include the Bronze Star with Valor and an Oak Leaf Cluster and a Purple Heart with an Oak Leaf Cluster.



Tom was born on December 9, 1941, in Washington, D.C., to Maj. Gen. Charles G. and Marion Calloway. Following completion of ROTC and graduation from the University of Richmond, he was commissioned as a U.S. Army 2nd Lt. in the Infantry and first assigned to the 5th Infantry Division at Fort Carson, Colorado.

In 1970 he met his future wife Emma S. Calloway while stationed at Fort Knox, Kentucky, and they married at Fort Myers, Virginia, in 1971.

Tom always amused his family and friends with his witty sense of humor and was a beloved husband and father who will be greatly missed.
